



CNL Recertification Schedule

Recertification applications may be submitted any time prior to the due date if the certificant meets criteria. Certificants renewing early are not penalized by adjusting an earlier expiration – the new recertification expiration date is based upon the previous expiration date. **Early submission is recommended.**

The recertification application should be filed with CNC no later than thirty (30) days prior to the expiration. All practice hours, contact hours, and graduate course work must be earned prior to the certification expiration date to apply towards recertification – activities towards recertification must have occurred within the five-year recertification period.

Certification Expiration: CNL certification is recognized for a period of five (5) years. The actual expiration date of a CNL certification is December 31st of the 5th complete year after certification (i.e. certification of CNLs initially certified in April 2008 expires December 31, 2013).
