

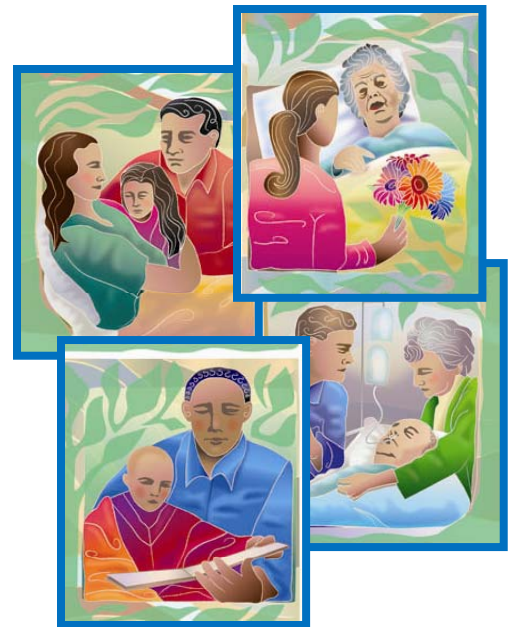
IMPROVING QUALITY OF LIFE AND QUALITY OF CARE FOR ONCOLOGY FAMILY CAREGIVERS

ONCOLOGY FAMILY CAREGIVER COURSE

The goal of this course is to improve quality of care and quality of life for oncology family caregivers by educating *competitively chosen interdisciplinary teams*, from across the nation, in improving care, support, and resources for oncology family caregivers. Using a goal-directed teaching method, each team will develop three goals related to implementation of family caregiver support activities in their home institution.

This 3-day course uses a Quality-of-life (QOL) Model to address physical, psychological, social, and spiritual well-being of oncology family caregivers.



Each team selected will receive:

- Free Registration and Course Materials
- Meals (breakfast, lunch and snacks)
- \$350 stipend per person applied to hotel cost at the Paradise Pier Hotel
- 17 CE credits (RN & SW) granted for full attendance of course. Other disciplines receive a Certificate of Attendance
- 6, 12, and 18 month follow-up and support
